

Basic Mouse

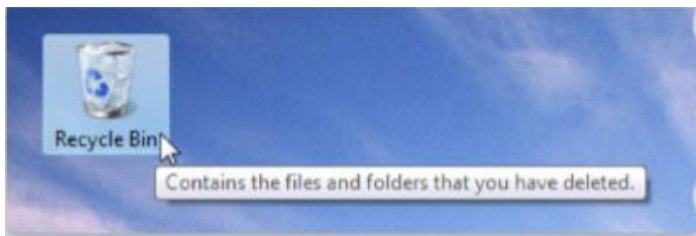


Definition: A hand-operated electronic device that controls the coordinates of a cursor on your computer screen as you move it around on a pad; on the bottom of




the device is a ball that rolls on the surface of the pad; “a mouse takes much more room than a trackball“

Directions on Holding the Mouse • Hold the mouse gently with your index finger resting on the primary button and your thumb resting on the side. • To move the mouse, slide it slowly in any direction.

Functions of the Mouse • Left Click - Selects and highlights • Right Click - Opens a menu • Double Click - Opens a program • Click and drag - Organizes items
